

In Board of Street Commissioners of the City of Boston, July 17, 1930.  
 Ordered:—That due notice be given, that this Board is of the opinion that, in said city, a public improvement should be made, consisting of the laying out and construction of Foster street, Hyde Park district, as a highway, from Loring street southeasterly, with the name of Chittick road or some other distinctive name,

substantially as shown on a plan in the office of this Board, that it intends to pass an order for making said improvements, and that it appoints 11 o'clock M., of July 31, 1930, 192x, and the office of this Board as the time and place for a public hearing in the matter.

In Board of Street Commissioners of the City of Boston, October 3, 1930.  
 Ordered:—That this Board, having passed the order of notice relating to the public improvement hereinafter described, and having caused a copy of said order to be published July 18, 19, 1930, 192, and July 21, 22, 1930, 192, in the Boston Post and the Boston Transcript, two daily newspapers published in the City of Boston, and having given the public hearing, notice of which was given in said order, and being of the opinion that public convenience so requires, does hereby order the making, in said city of the public improvements, shown on a plan, marked "City of Boston Chittick Rd. Hyde Park June 21, 1930 Wm. J. Sullivan Chief Engineer Street Laying-out Department", deposited in the office of the Street Laying-Out Department of said city, and named, bounded and described as follows:—

A highway named Chittick road is hereby laid out, from Loring street southeasterly for a distance of approximately ten hundred and eleven feet, and ordered constructed.

Said highway and the land, exclusive of trees or structures standing upon or affixed thereto, in which an easement for street purposes is hereby taken, is bounded and described as follows:

Northwesterly by Loring street, forty feet; northeasterly by the northeasterly line of Chittick road as hereby laid out, ten hundred ten and 73/100 feet; southeasterly by the southeasterly line of said Chittick road as hereby laid out, forty feet, and southwesterly by the southwesterly line of said Chittick road as hereby laid out, ten hundred ten and 91/100 feet.

Trees or structures standing upon or affixed to the aforescribed land shall be removed therefrom within sixty days following a notice of the City's intention to enter upon said land for the purpose of constructing said improvement.

Betterments are to be assessed for the making of the aforesaid improvement.

ORDERED: That this Board estimates that the abutting lots of land on both sides of Chittick road, from Loring street southeasterly for a distance of approximately ten hundred and eleven feet, will receive benefit or advantage beyond the general advantage to all real estate in said city, from the improvement herein ordered; each of said lots to the amount hereinafter respectively set against it; said lots and the supposed owners thereof being shown on a plan marked "City of Boston Chittick Rd. Hyde Park Assessment Plan July 25, 1929 Wm. J. Sullivan Chief Engineer Street Laying-Out Department" and on file in the office of said department.


