

death of my son Lawrence said trustee shall hold said trust estate in trust to pay over the same as follows:-

One half of said estate to the children of my deceased sister Mary Mc Mahan, wife of James Mc Mahan in equal shares, the children of any deceased child to take the share to which its parent would be entitled by right of representation. The remaining half of said estate in equal shares to all of the children of my deceased brother John Bonigan except the Reverend Michael J. Bonigan, the share to which George Bonigan would be entitled under this clause shall be paid to his mother Bridget Bonigan to her own use knowing that she will pay to said George Bonigan so much thereof as she deems necessary. The children of any deceased child to take the share to which its parent would be entitled, by right of representation.

4th. Said trustee shall have full power to invest said property in such manner as he may see fit, and the investment thereof to change from time to time at his discretion, with full power and authority to sell and convey the same, or any part thereof, without license or authority from any court (and no purchaser shall be bound to see to the application of the purchase money) and the proceeds of such sale to invest and reinvest at his discretion.

And it is my desire that said Rev. James J. Chittick shall be exempted from furnishing any surety on his bond as such trustee.

Sixth. I hereby nominate and appoint my wife Rose Bonigan to be the executor of this my last will and testament and request that she be exempt from furnishing any surety on her bond. In token of all which I hereto set my hand and seal this third day of November A.D. 1902.
